

This is one of those books that is more helpful in what is causes you to think about than what it says about it. Most of what it says is good, but none so helpful as just the act of bringing up the subject on a popular level.

Fortunately, much of what Dr. Sax says about plastics is now outdated, largely thanks to his own work. Companies are reacting to either the research or the popular effect of books like this one and removing the chemicals he talks about from their products. I wonder if a new edition is in the works.

Sections about the nature of boys seem to me to be right on the mark. Give them time and consideration.

If you're the parent of a troubled boy and you're looking for a saving answer, you might find some help here, but don't set your expectations too high. If you're interested in the subject, you'll love the book. If you're the parent of a baby or young boy, you'll find the advice and information here helpful. If you're an educator or anyone who works with children, you'll find some worthwhile thoughts and principles.
